Fifty years ago, a world-wide global market emerged to insure a good balance between offer and demand in the Oils and Fats business, to satisfy the quantitative needs of the food industry for the basic lipid raw materials. However, recent data dealing with human nutrition put up to reconsider the needs, with respect to ageing, physiological condition and activity of man. All this is linked to fundamental evolutions of the whole economic field from crops to manufacture. Farming should move to sustainable production systems, including genetic or genomic approaches. Starting from those varying raw materials, the upstream industry as well as the manufacturers are hardly asked by the consumers to move to environmental friendly processes, using updated results from the research in biochemistry, biotechnology and food physics.
